


Americans Overwhelmingly Support Expanding Clean Energy in the U.S.

National Survey Results from Public Opinion Strategies and Hart Research*


93% of American voters say clean energy is important to the country's energy future.



80% of Americans believe that clean energy is as reliable or more reliable than traditional generation sources.



Four in five voters, and a majority across party lines, support providing tax incentives for the expansion of the clean energy industry.




86% of voters believe it is important that the clean energy industry plays a major role in growing our economy by creating good-paying jobs in a fast-growing industry.



89% of Americans favor upgrading the transmission and power grid to enable the expansion of clean energy to more communities.



83% of voters believe it is important that transitioning to majority carbon free energy sources like land-based wind, offshore wind, and solar will help drive the clean energy economy forward while also benefiting our environment.
