2025 Safety First Workforce Campaign **GIVEAWAY CRITERIA**

ACP <u>Safety First Workforce Campaign</u> delivers the latest safety practices to your job sites and offices. This year, we're organizing giveaways to recognize individuals and teams that engage in the campaign. See below to understand how to be eligible for these giveaways. INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

To support the Safety First Workforce Campaign, ACP is hosting a series of PowerCasts on electrical safety topics, including incorporating electrical safety by design practices, designing a Qualified Electrical Worker Program, creating a strong electrical safety culture, and applying electrical safe work practices in the field. These PowerCasts are scheduled for October 15, 22, and 29 at 1 – 2pm ET.

Each week, an individual award will be given to a person that attends the PowerCasts, with three total awards granted. This award is open to employees of members and non-members.

During the PowerCasts, ACP will compile the names of attendees into a virtual "wheel of names" application. At the end of the PowerCast presentation, ACP will "spin the wheel" to randomly select one individual award winner. This individual will be announced during the PowerCasts and ACP will contact them after the PowerCasts to coordinate shipment of their award.



TEAM AWARDS

At the conclusion of the Safety First Workforce Campaign, ACP will recognize one team that demonstrates consistent participation in the campaign. The team award is intended to encourage managers to organize their teams of technicians or office staff to gather and view the <u>Safety First Shorts</u> during morning briefings and/or live <u>PowerCasts</u> lunch meetings. For the purposes of this award, a team is defined as one group of people for one job site or office.

To be considered for this award, you must submit a participation record to ACP that includes the following information:

- Company Name
- Instructor/Manager Name
- Date & PowerCast Title
- Attendee Names







A participation record should be submitted for each Safety First Short and/or PowerCast a team attends. Attendance records must be submitted to <u>safety@cleanpower.org</u> no later than November 3, 2025. Please use this subject line for your submission: "Safety First Workforce Team Award – [Company Name] Submission:"

ACP will select the team award winner based on the team that demonstrates their participation in the greatest number of Safety First Short and/or PowerCast sessions. The team that demonstrates the highest level of participation will be awarded. If multiple teams demonstrate the same level of participation, ACP will randomly select the Team Award winner.

The Team Award will be recognized no later than November 7, 2025. This award is open to members and non-members.
