The Certified Clean Energy Professionals Program (CCEPP) is an industry-developed certification framework created by the American Clean Power Association (ACP) in collaboration with the Clean Power Institute and industry leaders to establish aligned, portable, competency-based certifications for clean energy technicians.

The program was developed in response to growing industry demand for a more standardized approach to technician competency, safety, and workforce readiness as the clean energy sector continues to scale globally.



CCEPP certifications are designed to:

- ✓ Improve safety and technician competency across the industry
- ✓ Create greater consistency in workforce expectations
- ✓ Reduce duplication in training and onboarding
- ✓ Support workforce mobility and career progression
- ✓ Strengthen technician retention and professionalism
- ✓ Build greater confidence in technician readiness across employers, contractors, and training providers



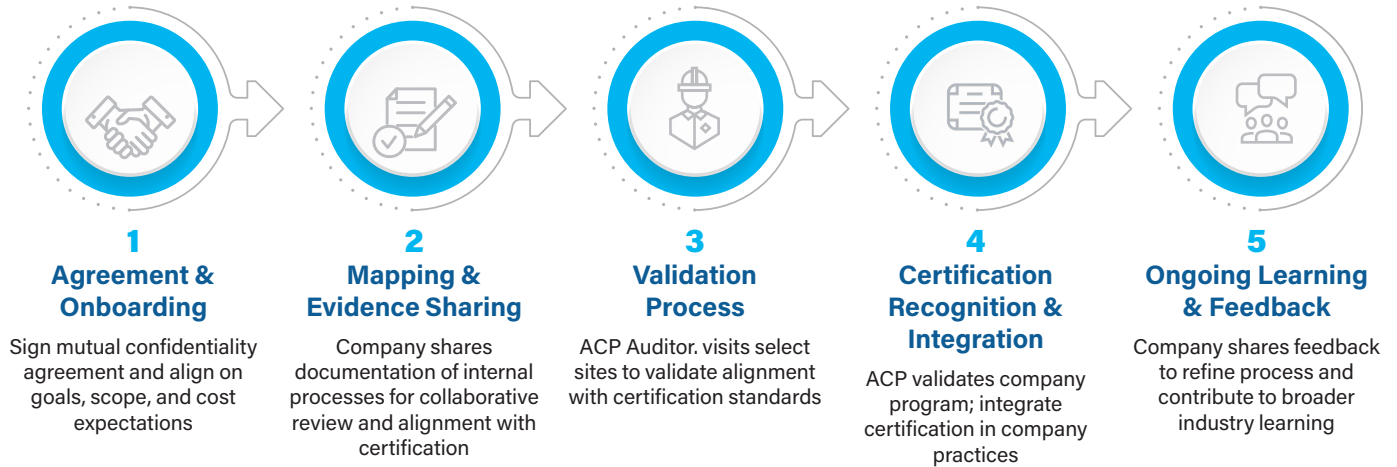
CCEPP certifications are:

- **Competency-based** — focused on demonstrated skills and applied knowledge
- **Training-agnostic** — technicians may come from company programs, community colleges, workforce programs, military pathways, or other training providers
- **Portable** — certifications are industry-recognized and designed to transfer across employers
- **Industry-aligned** — built with direct input from companies and operational experts

Adoption process for large companies

ACP offers a tailored approach that considers scale and cost for large companies to integrate the CCEPP into their existing technician qualification, training, or competency-based assessment systems. The goal is to recognize and build upon internal strengths while providing a nationally recognized, third-party certification that supports safety, performance, and workforce development at scale.
